## Scholarship available by the Walter Panzirer family

The Mitchell Area Crime Stoppers, Inc. is pleased to have the opportunity to administer and award an annual scholarship of \$5,000 made available by the Walter Panzirer family. The scholarship is awarded to an eligible student who meets the following criteria:

- Applicants must be the son or daughter, step-son or step-daughter, or adopted child of an active or former member of law enforcement.
- This scholarship will be awarded to an applicant who is currently a resident, or who has formerly been a resident of the state of South Dakota
- Current South Dakota State residents will be given preference.
- Scholarship applicants can pursue any degree; however, Applicants who are pursuing a field in Criminal Justice will be given preference.
- Applicants must attend a post-secondary education facility (after high school graduation). An Applicant(s) must be in their junior or senior year pursuing a 4-year college degree, or must be a student attending a post-secondary education facility in pursuit of an associate degree (first or second year student) at the time that the scholarship is awarded (in the fall of 2012). A person may apply for this scholarship prior to attending a post-secondary educational facility as long as the applicant meets the eligibility requirements at the time that they receive the scholarship award.
