- Abbey DeWolf was named All-GPAC for both women's golf and basketball during each year of her career (2001-04) at DWU, thus obtaining eight total All-Conference awards. Her sister, Casey DeWolf, was also instrumental in helping get the women's golf program started by becoming a two-time All-GPAC honoree as well.
- The 2003-04 DWU women's golf team was the first to participate in the NAIA National Tournament in school history. The team placed 10th, and the low individual was Amanda Young in 18th place. This breakout season would pave the way for continued conference and national success.
- Since 2003, the DWU women's golf team has remained in every NAIA Top 25 Poll conducted. The highest team rating is No. 8 in the nation, while the lowest team rating has been No. 23.
- The Wesleyan women's golf team has won six of the last seven GPAC titles.
- During the 2005-06 season, Heather Snavelly placed in the top three in seven of 11 tournaments. She became the first NAIA All-American in DWU golf history.
