Other Highlights

- In 1967, Mel Melcher (177) went undefeated during the regular season (21-0). He won the SDIC in his weight class and placed sixth in the NAIA National Meet.
- John Weber ended his career in 1969 as conference champ with a 15-1 record.
- In 1971, Pete Buatti won the SDIC and finished fifth in the NAIA National Meet.
- In 1997, DWU had eight national qualifiers, the most in university history. DWU also had eight national qualifiers in 2001.
- The 2001 DWU wrestling team finished 12th at the NAIA National Meet, marking the highest finish in university history.
- In 2002, Justin Portenier won the 125-pound weight class at the NAIA National Meet. Portenier became DWU's first-ever national champion in any sport.
