Randall Scholarships

Dakota Wesleyan University has been selecting Randall Scholars for more than 25 years. The highest academic award given at DWU, Randall Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis to academically successful high school seniors who display a strong talent for leadership and service. Students must have a minimum 3.5 GPA and 24 ACT or 1090 SAT to compete for a Randall Scholarship. A current leadership resume must be submitted before Feb. 3; attendance at Randall Scholarship Day is required, and a personal interview will be conducted. A limited number of Randall Scholars are named each year. Those successful in achieving Randall Scholar status will receive additional awards and the option of a book stipend or credit toward a Wesleyan-sponsored study abroad experience. A luncheon honoring all participants and their families will close the program Friday afternoon.

About Ron and Charlys Randall

The Randall Scholarships were established by Ron and Charlys Randall in memory of Ron's father, F. Dwain "Doc" Randall. Starting with a small grocery store in Flandreau, S.D., Doc Randall built a grocery business encompassing 37 stores in a seven-state area. Doc served on the board of trustees for Dakota Wesleyan University from 1975 until his death in October 1981. Ron is the former owner and CEO of Randall Stores Inc., and Charlys is a past member of the DWU Board of Trustees. The first Randall Scholarships were awarded in February 1984.

Expectations of Randall Scholars

It will be expected that all Randall Scholars:

- Maintain a 3.5 cumulative GPA
- Assist the admissions office with future scholarship and recruitment events
- Assist the institutional advancement/alumni office with fundraising and events
- Be positive role models and advocate to and for DWU in all areas of involvement – extracurricular, athletic participation, athletic events, in the classroom and in the community of Mitchell
