This program map formalizes the transfer of credits from the Criminal Justice A.A.S. degree from Western Dakota Tech (WDT) to the Criminal Justice B.A. Degree from Dakota Wesleyan University (DWU) under the following conditions:

The student will be granted credit the following DWU degree requirements for work done at WDT:

1. 63 credit hours toward the BA degree.
2. 15 upper level credits toward the required 42 for the BA degree.

The student must complete the following coursework at DWU:

1. A minimum of 62 additional total credits, as outlined below, of which at least 27 must be upper level credits.
