Graduation Rate

In accordance with the Higher **Education** Act of 1965, as amended, Dakota Wesleyan University is pleased to provide the following information on the graduation rates of our 2011 cohort of full-time, first-time, degree seeking undergraduates and student athletes that received athletic financial aid.

While reviewing this information, please keep the following in mind:

All graduation rates are based upon **6 years** of attendance which equates to 150% of the normal completion time of our longest program.

- These charts do not identify the reasons why our students withdrew; therefore, students who withdrew for personal or medical reasons are included.
- Graduation rates do not include students who left the school to serve in the armed forces or on official church missions or with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally and permanently disabled are excluded from the data.
- A pound sign (#) denotes any cohort/subcohort with five or fewer students. The university is not required to disclose this information.
