This program map formalizes the transfer of credits from the Criminal Justice – Law Enforcement Concentration A.A. degree from Northeast Community College (NORTHEAST) to the Criminal Justice B.A. Degree from Dakota Wesleyan University (DWU), under the following conditions:

The student will be granted credit the following DWU degree requirements for work done at NORTHEAST:

- 1. 60 credit hours toward the BA degree.
- 2. 11 upper level credits toward the required 30 for the B.A. degree.

The student must complete the following coursework at DWU:

- 1. A minimum of 57 additional total credits, as outlined below, of which at least 27 must be upper level credits.
- 2. The requirements in Appendix A, unless credit has been earned in equivalent NORTHEAST courses (in parentheses): (39 credits). See Appendix A
